Our Nation's Debt

Our Nation is in Deep Debt. We're spending money we don't have—we're borrowing from our kids; how will they pay it back. Here's an example: There's the overpriced, over budget and overdue F-35 Joint Strike Fighter, "including eight additional planes for the Air Force, six for the Navy, and two for the Marine Corps. In development for nearly 18 years and eight years behind schedule, total acquisition costs now exceed \$428 billion; nearly double the initial estimate of \$233 billion. A 2019 DOD Selected Acquisition Report noted that the F-35's lifetime operation and maintenance costs will total approximately \$1.2 trillion, the most expensive weapon system in US history."

This is the Pentagon's equivalent of California's ludicrous \$77 billion high-speed rail project, which at least has been sharply cut back. Unfortunately, when it comes to federal spending, failure is never a sufficient reason to stop.
