Once you have created an account look at the column Legion Membership summary. Look for view details, click on it then scroll down until you find the auto renew block. You will probably have to enter your credit card information to get auto renew set up. Once you have done that your dues will auto renew every year. If you need help in setting up an account, please contact me and I will help you get it set up.

Have a change of address, email address, phone number, or any other changes, please forward it to me so I can keep our data base up to date.

Do you have neighbors near you flying an American flag? Would you like to receive a membership recruiting pin from the National Commander? 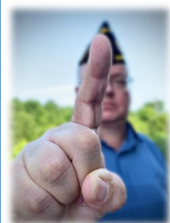


Veteran/Military Food Pantry

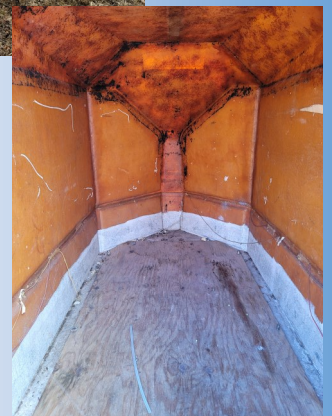
