What is Veterans Day and why?

Veterans Day is celebrated on Friday, November 11, 2022. November 11 became an official national holiday in the United States in 1938. In 1954 the name was changed to Veterans Day to honor those who had served in all U.S. wars.

Why is Veterans Day always on the 11th?

The holiday was first called Armistice Day. It was established after World War I to remember the "war to end all wars," and it was pegged to the time that a cease-fire, or armistice, occurred in Europe on November 11, 1918.

Is Veterans Day for everyone who served?

Veterans Day, observed every November 11, recognizes all who have served in the Armed Forces.

Who do you honor on Veterans Day?

While those who died are also remembered, Veterans Day is the day set aside to thank and honor ALL those who served honorably in the military - in wartime or peacetime.

The post has 700 members renewed as of October 21, 2022. If you know of a member who has not renewed their dues, PLEASE have them contact me to pay them.

National has implemented a new method for renewing your dues. First you need to create an account at mylegion.org. Once you have created an account look at the column Legion Membership summary. Look for view details, click on it then scroll down until you find the auto renew block. You will probably have to enter your credit card information to get auto renew set up. Once you have done that your dues will auto renew every year. If you need help in setting up an account, please contact me and I will help you get it set up.

Renewal notices have been mailed by National. When you receive your notice, PLEASE send it in. I would like to see the Post reach 1015 renewals (last year's members renewed) by December 2022. The goal for the Post as determined by State is 1021. There are several ways to renew your dues, first is to pay online at https://www.legion.org/ second is to mail them to the post or visit the post and pay them in person. When you mail in your renewal it comes to the post not National. Have a change of address, email address, phone number, or any other changes, please forward it to me so I can keep out data base up to date.

With the new leadership in place for the next year, it is time to discuss your involvement in the Post. Over the last several years the Post leadership has essentially been the same people. For a Post with over 1000 members that breaks down to about 1 0r 2%. To ensure that YOUR Post will be here for many years to come, it is imperative that all members become involved with the Post. 


